

Quick Facts

Check-in time - Check-in time is 12 noon. Earlier check-in to your bure or treehouse is permitted subject to availability.

Check-out time - Check-out time is 10:00 a.m. Day use of a bure for afternoon departures is permitted (no charge) subject to availability. If a bure is not available for day use, your luggage will be collected from your bure at 10:00 a.m. and stored in our Sawana Lounge located in the same building as our Ocean Spa.

Nightly tariff inclusions - Our nightly tariff includes accommodation, all meals, daily maid service and evening turn-down service, daily laundry service, non-motorised activities, and a variety of cultural activities. Round-trip car and boat transfers that are not prepaid will be added to your final bill for settlement on your departure.

Nightly tariff exclusions - Our nightly tariff excludes beverages (alcoholic and non-alcoholic), mini bar, motorised activities, scuba diving, scuba gear hire, scuba day trip surcharge for diving the Somosomo Straits/Rainbow Reef dive sites, excursions on Taveuni Island, private picnics in Horseshoe Bay, private candlelit dinners, spa services and other incidental items.

Prepaid romance package - If you have prepaid our Romance Package you will also receive the following additional services; a picnic in Horseshoe Bay with a bottle of house wine, a private candlelit dinner for two with a special menu and a bottle of house wine, and a 30-minute couples massage in our Ocean Spa. NB: There are two picnic times; Morning Picnic 9:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. and Afternoon Picnic 1:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.



Wifi connectivity - 4G Wifi connectivity is currently available in the dining room only free of charge. The password will be provided on your check-in.

Office hours - Our office is open between 6:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. daily. Should you require assistance outside of these hours, please report to the nightwatchman stationed at the activities bure.

Medical assistance - Basic First Aid only is available here at Matangi. The closest hospital is situated 20 miles away at Waiyevo on the island of Taveuni. Should you require medical assistance at any time please inform our concierge or front office team as soon as possible. For after hours assistance please report to the nightwatchman stationed at the activities bure.

Your departure time - Our front office team will inform you of your boat departure time one day prior to your departure date. To ensure that we have your correct details for your flight to Nadi or other onward travel arrangements, please give this information to our front office team as early as possible. Normal breakfast service will be available for all early morning departures as well as lunch service for all afternoon departures.

Settlement of final account - All prices for purchases at Matangi are inclusive of 15% Fiji Government tax. All your purchases will be added to your room tab for settlement on your departure. Your final bill will be delivered to your bure during the nightly turn down service on your final night. We accept Visa, Mastercard and American Express. Merchant fees apply; Visa and Mastercard 3.5%, American Express 3.6%.

Oceanview Bures, Beachfront Bures, Treehouses with spa baths, a 2 bedroom Bure and a Beachfront Treehouse Villa with plunge pool

Water - Drinking water is provided in the glass bottles and is replenished daily. The tap water is perfectly safe for brushing your teeth and showering. This water comes from a clean mountain spring on Qamea Island that is piped across the channel into storage tanks on Matangi.

Electricity - Our power supply is 240-volt AC 50 hertz. Please ensure your devices are compatible prior to plugging them in. Plug adapters are available from front office for loan.

Mini Bar - A Mini Bar Request List will be provided to you at your checkin registration. Your housekeeper will happily assist you with your mini bar requests, charges apply. Air-conditioning - Your four poster bed canopy is equipped with a modern low power consumption air-conditioning unit allowing for a cool and comfortable sleep. Your housekeeper will prepare the mosquito net canopy during her turndown service. We would appreciate it if you could please keep the air-conditioner turned off when not in use.

Safety deposit box - We encourage you to use the safety deposit box to store your valuable personal items during your stay and to lock your bure when it is vacant. Matangi takes no responsibility for personal items that may be misplaced or lost.



Room service - We are happy to provide room service during normal meal times. Daily menu choices apply. If you are feeling unwell and require room service please inform the dining room staff. They would be happy to have the chefs prepare something special for you.

Laundry - Complimentary laundry service (wash, fold and iron) is provided daily at no charge. Matangi takes no responsibility for laundry that is lost or damaged.

Bathrobe - A bathrobe is provided in your bure for your use during your stay and is recommended for your spa appointments.

Flashlight - We encourage you to use your flashlight to aide you at night in navigating the toads, crab holes and roots that regularly pop up on our natural pathways.

Barefoot Gourmet Dining

Our cuisine is largely influenced by the availability of freshly grown produce and locally sourced fish and seafood. Every effort is made by our team of local chefs to use house-made ingredients and to include a touch of Fijian flavour in our dishes.

Breakfast is a buffet of cereals, fresh tropical fruit, fruit juices, coffee and tea, and freshly baked treats. Hot breakfast choices are also available off our Hot Breakfast Menu.

Lunch consists of a light salad followed by a main of your choice and a light dessert.

Dinner consists of a choice of a starter, main and dessert.

To allow ample time for our chefs to prepare your meals, the day's menu will be made available at the completion of the breakfast service. Special dietary needs can be catered for, advance notice is appreciated.

Meal times - Breakfast 7:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m., Lunch 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m., Dinner 7:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.



All day snacks - Coffee, tea and freshly sweet baked treats are available in the dining room at all times. If you have a preference for something more savoury, please ask a member of the dining team to arrange this for you.

Dress code - Out of respect to your fellow diners please ensure that you are dressed appropriately during meal times. As it is customary in Fiji for shoes not to be worn inside, shoes are optional in our dining room.

Beverages - Our tariff excludes all beverages. All bar purchases will be added to your room tab as cash is not accepted at the bar. Beverages not purchased at our bar are not permitted in the dining room including the bar, lounge and pool areas.





















All Inclusive Free Activities

Please check our "Daily Post" for daily activities times.

Snorkelling - Morning and afternoon snorkelling excursions depart daily at 10:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Our friendly staff at the activities bure will be happy to fit you out with your snorkelling equipment for you to use for the duration of your stay. If you wish to snorkel off the resort's beach frontage we ask that you adhere to the following for your safety; inform a member of the activities staff prior to going snorkelling, ensure you snorkel with a buddy, and always take a snorkel safety marker with you from the activities bure. These safety markers make you visible to any boats that may pass through the area where you are snorkelling and help to keep you safe.


Kayaks - Are available at the activities bure for your use. For your safety we ask that you wear a personal safety device available at the activities bure. Our friendly activities staff will be happy to help you launch your kayak into the water and give you useful tips for kayaking around Matangi.

Calypso sailing catamaran - We have 2 sailing catamarans available for your use. Basic sailing skills are essential. If you are interested in sailing lessons our friendly activities staff will be happy to assist. For your safety please wear a personal safety device while sailing.

Matangi island tour - Once a week we provide a guided boat tour around Matangi. Not only is this a great way to get you orientated with the island's layout, it is also the best way to view Matangi's stunning coastline, surrounding coral reefs and turquoise waters. Hand-line fishing - The waters around Matangi offer a variety of great eating reef fish including Coral trout, Trevally and Reef snapper. Typically 10-25lb line with some lead weight and a small hook attached to a hand- line caster reel is used. Hand-line fishing is done from a skiff. Sun hat, sunscreen and bottle of water essential.

Matangi coastal trail - A natural trail along Matangi's coastline provides an easy walk to the island's eastern most tip where the sun rises. If you a morning person and like a little exercise before you start your day this is a great walk for you. Allow at least one hour or longer if you are a slow walker. If walking in the afternoon please allow enough time to return to the resort before dark.

Bush hike - Matangi's volcanic ridge top trail offers a more challenging but very scenic hike. As the trail is steep, narrow, rocky and slippery in some parts, a good degree of care must be exercised at all times. Allow 3 hours to do the full hike. Shoes with good traction, hat and bottle of water essential. Hiking sticks are also available from the activities bure. For your safety, ensure that you notify our activities staff prior to your hike. If hiking in the afternoon, it is essential that you plan your hike to allow enough time to return to the resort before dark. The light fades very quickly under the forest canopy after 4:00 p.m. Matangi is home to a variety of domesticated livestock including cattle, sheep, pigs and goats. While normally harmless these animals should not be provoked. If you happen to encounter them during your coastal walk or ridge-top hike, please respect their space.
































All Inclusive Free Activities

Village tour - Once a week we offer a village tour to Togo Village on the neighbouring island of Qamea. Enjoy the warm hospitality of the locals and observe everyday village life. It is customary that a small kava ceremony of welcome or sevusevu is performed upon arrival in the village. You are welcome to drink the kava however please note the water in the village is not treated. A fee of \$50 FJD per person is payable at the village. (Cash in Fiji Dollars only accepted). Your contribution greatly helps funding projects that benefit the entire village. NB: A small fee will be billed to your room tab to cover the cost of the kava gift to the village, approximately \$30 FJD per visit to be shared equally by all guests on the village tour.

School visit - During the school terms, we also visit Vuanicau Primary School in Togo village. Though sometimes shy; the school children are always curious and happy to receive visitors. If you have school supplies to donate, or you wish to make a financial donation to the school our front office team will be happy to assist you.

Sunday church service - Methodist Church services are available every Sunday at Soso Settlement on the neighbouring island of Qamea. The Fijian service can take between one and two hours.

Coconut show - Once a week our activities staff hosts a fun coconut show. Learn about the many uses the coconut tree offers Fijians. Participate in the weaving of hats and baskets, the husking and scraping of coconut and the preparation of fresh coconut milk for cooking. Kava & Talanoa session - Once a week our staff hosts an informal kava session with talanoa or story telling. Kava also known as Yaqona is an infusion prepared from the root of Piper methysticum, a member of the pepper family. Considered Fiji's national drink kava is always present in every occasion both formal and informal for welcoming and bonding. Come along and enjoy a bowl or two of kava and share stories with our friendly staff.

Handicraft show - Village women have learned to be very resourceful making use of raw materials readily available on the land to make mats and brooms for their household use as well as tapa bark cloth for formal ceremonies including weddings and funerals. Tapa or traditional Fijian bark cloth plays a key role in Fijian society. No traditional or formal ceremony takes place without it. The patterns painted onto the cloth tell a story and indicate the part of Fiji where they are created. We are fortunate to have the women of Togo Village visit us once a week to demonstrate how to make tapa, weave mats from pandanus and brooms from coconut fronds. The women will also have a small selection of handcraft items for sale. The women accept Fiji Dollars only.


Cooking demonstration - Once a week our chefs host an informal cooking demonstration where they share tips on how to make some classic local dishes including coconut prawn curry made with freshly squeezed coconut milk, hand- made roti flatbread and condiments made with seasonal fruits and a touch of Fijian style.

Bush medicine show - Bush medicine is still very much practiced in the islands. Our gardens and native bush are full of medicinal plants believed to cure a variety of ailments. Local experts in bush medicine will educate you on the medicinal herbs available in the islands, their uses, preparation and application. This is an interesting show for keen gardeners, herbalists and anyone with a keen interest in natural medicine.





















Horseshoe Bay Picnic

There isn't anything quite like a romantic picnic in the breathtaking Horseshoe Bay. Listed in "1,000 Places to See Before you Die" by Patricia Schultz, Horseshoe Bay is situated on the untouched western coast of Matangi Island and is accessible only by boat. Your picnic bure, with bathroom and shower facilities, hanging sofa bed, bean bags and sun lounges, provides all the comfort you require for your picnic in Horseshoe Bay. Snorkelling equipment, kayaks and stand up paddle boards are also available for your use. To ensure that all couples have the opportunity to experience this magical place, there are two picnic times.

While every effort is made to ensure your privacy in Horseshoe Bay, under maritime law visiting yachts and local boats cannot legally be stopped or prevented from entering Horseshoe Bay. All mariners who visit Horseshoe Bay are informed of our private picnics and are asked to respect the privacy of our guests. Certified Scuba Diving

Our daily dive program includes two dives in the morning with the dive boat departing Matangi after breakfast; with a surface interval done between the dives either on the boat, or a deserted beach then returning to the resort for lunch. Daily two tank dive rate is \$350 FJD per diver. Mask, snorkel and fins are included free of charge. Full set (BCD, Regulator, Wetsuit, Dive Computer,) gear hire rate \$85 FJD per diver, per day.

Shore diving is available off the beach in front of the Activities Bure. One-Tank Shore Dive Rate \$55 FJD per diver. Shore dives are complimentary with our pre-booked and pre-paid packages. Divers must dive with a buddy at all times and our dive crew must be informed of your shore dive prior to diving.

Open Water Dive Certification is the minimum requirement for scuba diving at Matangi. Divers are required to produce a dive certification card. Dive Insurance including emergency medical evacuation is recommended.

To ensure the best dive experience, dive sites are selected according to daily tidal movements, prevailing weather conditions and skill level of the diver. For information on the day's dive sites selection please see our dive team. Somosomo Strait Day Dive Trip Day dive trips to the more remote Somosomo Strait and location of the world famous Rainbow Reef and The Great White Wall is possible weather permitting and with a minimum of 4 divers. Due to the extra travel required, a fuel surcharge of \$290 FJD per diver applies. The option to do a third dive is included free of charge. This day trip requires an early morning departure around 7:00 a.m. and usually returns in the afternoon between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00.p.m.

Civa Pearl Farm

Visit Taveuni Island's only pearl farm 7 miles west of Matangi Island. Presentation, guided snorkelling in Wailoa Lagoon, and Fiji's finest pearls available for sale on site. An entrance fee of \$50 FJD per person is payable at the pearl farm. Visa, Mastercard, Discover Card, PayPal and Apple Pay accepted. The round-trip boat transfers from Matangi Island are \$95 FJD per person, minimum 4. This fee will be added to your room tab.

Civa (Fiji) Pearls Ltd was founded in 2006 by Canadian expats Claude Michel Prevost and Danielle Belanger. They began pearl production in 2007, with a first harvest in 2010. Most of their pearls are exported to Europe, with a small amount available in Fiji.

The pearl farm, located on Taveuni, the 3rd largest island in Fiji, covers 55 hectares in Wailoa Lagoon. Fijian pearls are renowned for their natural colors.

Civa (Fiji) Pearls Ltd believes in community reinvestment for mutual long-term growth. They work closely with local fishing rights owners and dedicate at least 2.5% of revenue to community projects, often more. They also focus on sustainable operations and have established a Marine Protected Area, with plans for reef rehabilitation.

The proteced marine area also boasts some of the best snokelling in the area with an abundance of sea life on display.





















Taveuni Island Tours

Tavoro Waterfalls - Bouma National Heritage Park Tavoro Falls, Fiji's most famous waterfall, is at the gateway of the 15000 hectare Bouma National Heritage Park and is easily reached by a 10 minute walk from the main road into the rainforest. The largest of the 3 waterfalls in the park, it also features the largest swimming pool and is the perfect spot for a swim. The trek up to the second and third waterfalls entails several serious slopes and crossings over creeks. An individual in good health should have no trouble at all. Hiking shoes and bottle of water essential. Guide, lunch and refreshments provided by Matangi. Round-trip car and boat transfers \$185 FJD per person. An entrance fee of \$50 FJD per person is payable at the park; cash FJD only accepted.

Lavena coastal walk - Bouma National Heritage Park If you're looking for a bit of adventure that's beyond the usual tourist sights on Taveuni, this 6 mile walk offers beautiful scenery beyond the furtherest village in the Bouma National Park. This 2-3 hour walk passes through various habitats of low-lying virgin forest and ending with two very picturesque waterfalls offering refreshing rock pools for swimming. The trail passes alongside sandy beaches, unusual rocky coastlines and estuarine mangroves with several shady picnic spots along the way. Hiking shoes and bottle of water essential. Guide, lunch and refreshments provided by Matangi. Round-trip car and boat transfers \$205 FJD per person. An entrance fee of \$40 FJD per person is payable at the park; cash FJD only accepted. Taveuni Island day tour - The third largest island in Fiji with a total land area of approximately 168 square miles and with a population of 20,000, Taveuni is also known as the Garden Island of Fiji for its rich biodiversity. This tour includes a visit to the Tavoro Waterfalls, 180 Meridian International Dateline, Wairiki Catholic Mission Church, Waitavala Waterslide and Naqara town centre. Guide, lunch and refreshments provided by Matangi. Round-trip car and boat transfers \$215 FJD per person. Tavoro Waterfalls entry fee \$50 FJD per person payable at the park.

Light Tackle Sport Fishing

Due to the seabed's topography off Matangi and neighbouring islands, remarkable fighting fish like Giant trevally, Yellowfin, Dogtooth, Skipjack, and Wahoo are plentiful.

Light tackle sport fishing, and trawling charters are available at an hourly rate of \$300 FJD. Ideal fishing times are early mornings and late afternoons.

Deep-sea game fishing is not available at Matangi. Saltwater flyfishing is available, but anglers must bring their own gear. The reef surrounding Matangi Island, extending approximately 1000 feet from the high water mark out to sea, is protected as a marine area. Fishing is not permitted inside this zone.




































